Call to Order: Joe Walker called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

<u>Secretary's Report:</u> Catherine Ebone—February 23, 2023, general meeting minutes were approved as submitted. 30 people attended in person with an additional 20 online.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Rebecca Poon—The financial report for February 2023 was given. Funds remaining at the end of February were given. Rebecca also stated that checks for Speaker's Bureau engagements need to be made out to St Charles County Master Gardeners.
